This week, we have been starting to write our own monster stories. Please try one of the following to do:

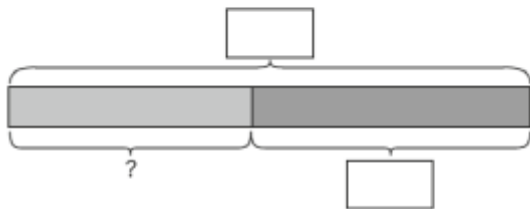
- 1) Draw and label a picture of your monster or hero.

How many oranges are there?

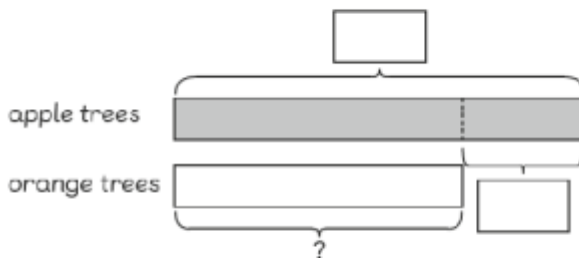
